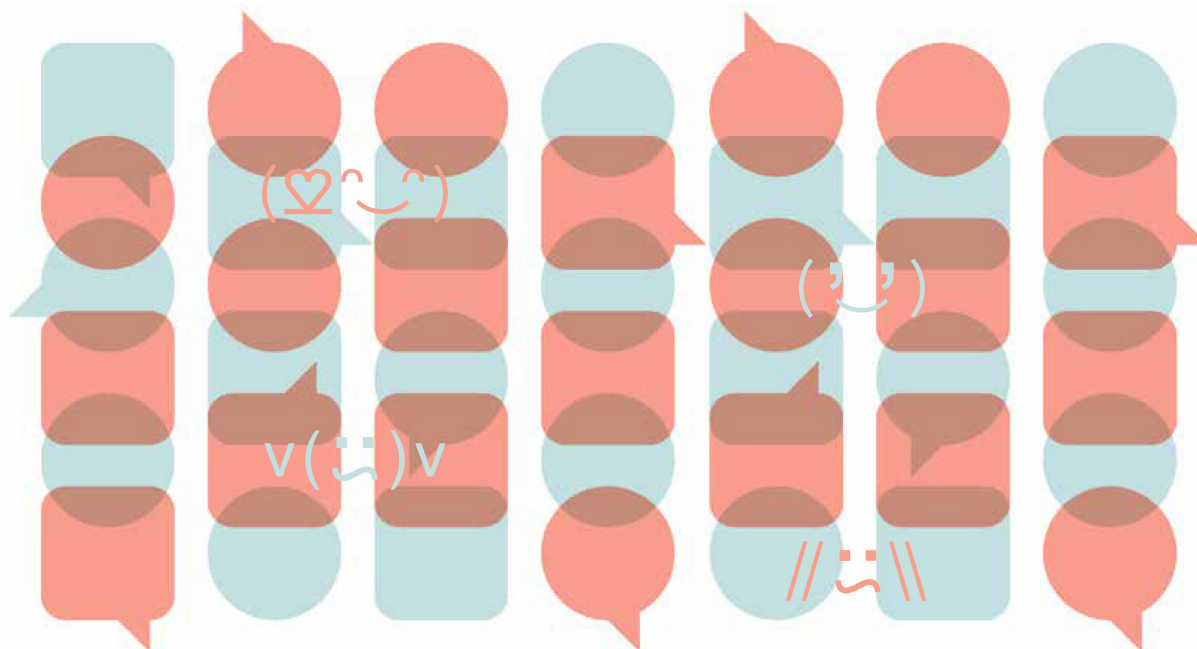


MAKING A DIFFERENCE
