

Dannielle Miller Biography

Dannielle Miller is the CEO of Enlighten Education, which conducts empowering workshops with more than 25,000 girls each year. She is also the founder of Goodfellas, whose presenters deliver empowering workshops to boys.

Dannielle is the author of five books including the best-selling *The Butterfly Effect: A Positive New Approach to Raising Happy, Confident Teen Girls*. She also has a bi-weekly column in the Saturday edition of *The Daily Telegraph*.

This year, as Education Officer for Women's Community Shelters, she launched *Walk The Talk*, an innovative new program aimed at teens that provides a practical application for learning about eliminating domestic violence. In March, she also launched *The School Toilet Project*, an initiative aimed at encouraging schools to let students reimagine these often bleak spaces.

Dannielle has been named the NSW/ACT Small Business Champion Entrepreneur and received an Australian Leadership Award. Last year, she was one of four Finalists for the NSW Premier's Woman of the Year Award, and the winner of The Suicide Prevention Australia award for media reporting. In 2019, she won the Westfield Hornsby Local Hero competition, which will fund expansion of her Walk The Talk program in this area.
