



## Penelope Hasking

- Keynote Monday 11 May

Penelope Hasking is an Associate Professor of Psychology at Curtin University. Her primary research interest is in Non-Suicidal Self-Injury (NSSI) an area she has been researching for over 15 years. Much of this work has focused on socio-cognitive factors that initiate and maintain NSSI in youth, the needs of school staff who address NSSI in the school setting, and the views of parents of young people who self-injure. As the co-founder, and Chair, of the International Consortium on Self-Injury in Educational Settings (ICSES), she has led an international position paper on how best to address NSSI in secondary schools, and co-authored an international approach to responding to NSSI on university campuses. A/Prof Hasking is current President of the International Society for the Study of Self-Injury.
